A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REQUIRING THE MOTOR FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION TO USE BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES IN OPERATING THE CENTRAL MOTOR POOL, TO USE A FORMULA TO DETERMINE THE MOST COST-EFFECTIVE REPLACEMENT OF VEHICLES, AND TO REPORT SEMIANNUALLY TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE COST SAVINGS RESULTING FROM USE OF THE FORMULA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-341(8)i.4. reads as rewritten:

"§ 143-341. Powers and duties of Department.

The Department of Administration has the following powers and duties:

...

(8) General Services:

...

i. To establish and operate a central motor pool and such subsidiary related facilities as the Secretary may deem necessary, and to that end:

...

4. To maintain, store, repair, dispose of, and replace state-owned motor vehicles under the control of the ~~Department.~~ Department, using best management practices. The Department shall ensure that state-owned vehicles are ~~not normally replaced until they have been driven for 110,000 miles or more when most cost effective using a replacement formula developed by the~~ Department and reviewed periodically for appropriateness of use. The Department shall report semiannually to the cochairs of the Joint Appropriations Subcommittee on General Government, on or before
