SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Clay Cou	
by proper resolution of its governing body, create a joint development agency,	•
to Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, with a contiguous cour	ity in an
adjoining state.	
SECTION 2. G.S. 160A-462(a) reads as rewritten:	
"(a) Units agreeing to an undertaking may establish a joint agency charge	_
any or all of the responsibility for the undertaking. The units may confer on	•
agency any power, duty, right, or function needed for the execution of the und	ertaking,
except that legal title to all real property necessary to the undertaking shall be	held by
the participating units individually, or jointly as tenants in common, in such ma	nner and
proportion as they may determine. undertaking, including the authority to hold l	egal title
to any real property necessary to the undertaking."	
SECTION 3. This act applies to Clay County only.	
SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
