<b>SECTION 1.</b> Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by a	dding a
new section to read:	
"§ 160A-296.1. Expenditure of funds for roads outside the corporate limits.	
A city may appropriate funds not otherwise limited as to use by law to co	<u>onstruct</u>
roadways in areas outside its corporate limits and outside its extraterritorial p	lanning
and zoning jurisdiction only if those roadways are owned by the State and mai	<u>ntained</u>
by the Department of Transportation. Notwithstanding the provisions of this se	ction, a
city may not construct roadways within the corporate limits of another muni	<u>cipality</u>
without that municipality's consent."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies to the City of Greensboro and the T	own of
Kernersville only.	

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
