4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-33(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
6	"(c) Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing
7	greater punishment, any person who commits any assault, assault and battery, or affray
8	is guilty of a Class A1 misdemeanor if, in the course of the assault, assault and battery,
9	or affray, he or she:
10	···
11	(7) Commits an assault on a minor by committing, in the presence of the
12	minor, an assault with a deadly weapon or an assault that inflicts
13	serious injury on a person with whom the person committing the
14	assault has a personal relationship. The following definitions shall
15	apply in this subdivision:
16	<u>a.</u> "In the presence of a minor" means:
17	<u>1.</u> <u>In the physical presence of the minor; or</u>
18	<u>And the second of the second </u>
19	hear the offense.
20	<u>b.</u> "Minor" is any person under the age of 18 years who is residing
21	with or is under the care and supervision of, and who has a
22	personal relationship with, the person assaulted or the person
23	committing the assault.
24	c. "Personal relationship" is as defined in G.S. 50B-1(b)."
25	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and applies to
26	offenses committed on or after that date.
