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Short Title: Toner/Inkjet Cartridges. (Public) Representatives Hackney, Sauls (Primary Sponsors); Insko and Lewis. April 10, 2003 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT MAKING VOID AND UNENFORCEABLE AS A MATTER OF PUBLIC POLICY ANY PROVISION IN ANY AGREEMENT OR CONTRACT THAT PROHIBITS THE REUSING, REMANUFACTURING, OR REFILLING OF A TONER OR INKJET CARTRIDGE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 75 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 75-36. Certain contracts relating to toner or inkjet cartridges void and unenforceable as a matter of public policy. Any provision in any agreement or contract that prohibits the reusing, remanufacturing, or refilling of a toner or inkjet cartridge is void and unenforceable as a matter of public policy." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
