5	SECT	<b>FION 1.</b> G.S. 143B-434.4(b) reads as rewritten:
6	"(b) Creat	ion of Account There is created in the Department of Commerce,
7	Division of Tou	arism, Film, and Sports Development, the Film Industry Development
8	L	vide annual grants as incentives to production companies that engage in
9	production acti	vities in this State. The Division of Tourism, Film, and Sports
10	Development sh	all administer this program in accordance with the following provisions:
11	(1)	To be eligible for a grant, a production company must engage in
12		production activities in this State with expenditures in this State of at
13		least one million dollars (\$1,000,000). A grant may not be used for
14		political or issue advertising.
15	(2)	A grant may not exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the amount the
16		production company spends has spent for goods and services in this
17		State during the calendar year.
18	(3)	A grant may not exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) per
19		production.
20	(4)	Grants shall be awarded to productions that substantially utilize North
21		Carolina's film industry infrastructure and workforce, that stimulate
22		economic activity within the State, and that create employment
23		opportunities within the State.
24	<u>(5)</u>	A grant may not be made unless there is a local government match of
25		the funds allocated by the State. A local match may include cash, fee

1	waivers, in-kind services, the donation of assets, the provision of
2	infrastructure, or a combination of these."
3	SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
4	Department of Commerce for the Film Industry Development Account the sum of five
5	million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year.
6	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
