A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE COLUMBUS COUNTY PRISON BE  
2 CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SAME NORTH CAROLINA  
3 STATE BUILDING CODE UNDER WHICH THE PRISONS IN SCOTLAND,  
4 ANSON, ALEXANDER, GREENE, AND BERTIE COUNTIES WERE  
5 CONSTRUCTED.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** The 1000-cell close security prototypical prison to be  
9 constructed in Columbus County shall be constructed in accordance with the North  
10 Carolina State Building Code, 1996 Edition through 1999 revisions, if construction  
11 starts before July 1, 2005. This section applies only if the construction documents have  
12 been reviewed and approved by the Department of Insurance, the State Construction  
13 Office, and the Department of Correction.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
