A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITIES OF CLINTON AND LUMBERTON AND THE
TOWN OF FRANKLIN TO DECLARE RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS IN
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TARGET AREAS UNSAFE AND TO
DEMOLISH THOSE BUILDINGS USING THE SAME PROCESS
AUTHORIZED FOR THE DEMOLITION OF UNSAFE NONRESIDENTIAL
BUILDINGS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2002-118 reads as rewritten:
"SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply to the Cities of Durham and
Fayetteville Clinton, Durham, Fayetteville, and Lumberton and the Towns of Franklin,
Hope Mills and Spring Lake only."
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
