The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2002-118, as amended by S.L.	2003-23,
reads as rewritten:	
"SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply to the Cities of Clinton	<u>,</u> Durham,
Fayetteville, Goldsboro, and High Point High Point, and Lumberton, and the	Towns of
Franklin, Hope Mills and Spring Lake only."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
