SENATE BILL 123 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITIES OF CLINTON AND LUMBERTON AND THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN TO DECLARE RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS IN COMMUNITY **DEVELOPMENT** TARGET **AREAS UNSAFE** AND **THOSE** DEMOLISH **BUILDINGS** USING THE **SAME PROCESS** AUTHORIZED FOR THE DEMOLITION OF UNSAFE NONRESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2002-118, as amended by S.L. 2003-23, reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 4.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply to the Cities of <u>Clinton</u>, Durham, Fayetteville, Goldsboro, and <u>High Point High Point</u>, and <u>Lumberton</u>, and the Towns of <u>Franklin</u>, Hope Mills and Spring Lake only."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
