## SESSION LAW 2003-42 SENATE BILL 123

## AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITIES OF CLINTON AND LUMBERTON AND THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN TO DECLARE RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS IN TARGET COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AREAS UNSAFE AND TO THOSE DEMOLISH BUILDINGS USING THE SAME PROCESS AUTHORIZED FOR THE DEMOLITION OF UNSAFE NONRESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 4 of S.L. 2002-118, as amended by S.L. 2003-23, reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 4.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply to the Cities of <u>Clinton</u>, Durham, Fayetteville, Goldsboro, and High Point High Point, and Lumberton, and the Towns of <u>Franklin</u>, Hope Mills and Spring Lake only."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2003.
