4	THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.
5	Whereas, Section 5 of Article XIV of the Constitution of North Carolina
6	states that it shall be a proper function of the State of North Carolina to acquire and
7	preserve park, recreational, and scenic areas, and in every other appropriate way to
8	preserve as a part of the common heritage of this State, its open lands and places of
9	beauty; and
10	Whereas, the 1987 General Assembly enacted the State Parks Act, which
11	declares that the State of North Carolina offers unique archaeological, geologic,
12	biological, scenic, and recreational resources, and that these resources are part of the
13	heritage of the people of the State, which should be preserved and managed by the
14	people for their use and for the use of their visitors and descendants; and
15	Whereas, the Lower Haw River in Chatham County is considered nationally
16	significant for its biological resources including several rare species and possesses
17	biological, scenic, and recreational resources of statewide significance; Now, therefore,
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
19	SECTION 1. The General Assembly authorizes the Department of
20	Environment and Natural Resources to add the Lower Haw River State Natural Area to
21	the State Parks System as provided by G.S. 113-44.14(b).
22	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
