March 12, 2003 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT ALLOWING A CLAIM FOR EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION TO SURVIVE 3 THE DEATH OF A SPOUSE WHEN THE PARTIES ARE LIVING SEPARATE 4 AND APART AT THE TIME OF DEATH AND THE CLAIM IS FILED WITHIN 5 SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF DEATH. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 50-20(1) reads as rewritten: 7 8 A pending action claim for equitable distribution shall not abate upon the "(1)death of a party.survives the death of a spouse so long as the parties are living separate 9 10 and apart at the time of death. Any claim for equitable distribution made after the death of a party must be filed within six months of the date of death." 11 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 12
