A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ENABLE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO SUSPEND FROM
2 SCHOOL THOSE STUDENTS WHO GIVE AWAY, SELL, OR USE
3 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, PRESCRIPTION DRUGS, OR CONTROLLED
4 SUBSTANCES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-391 reads as rewritten:

8 **"§ 115C-391. Corporal punishment, suspension, or expulsion of pupils.**

9 ...

10 (d3) A local board of education or superintendent shall suspend for 365 calendar
11 days any student who, by any means of communication to any person or group of
12 persons, makes a report, knowing or having reason to know the report is false, that there
13 is located on educational property or at a school-sponsored curricular or extracurricular
14 activity off educational property any device designed to destroy or damage property by
15 explosion, blasting, or burning, or who, with intent to perpetrate a hoax, conceals,
16 places, or displays any device, machine, instrument, or artifact on educational property
17 or at a school-sponsored curricular or extracurricular activity off educational property,
18 so as to cause any person reasonably to believe the same to be a bomb or other device
19 capable of causing injury to persons or property. The local board upon recommendation
20 by the superintendent may modify either suspension requirement on a case-by-case
21 basis that includes, but is not limited to, the procedures established for the discipline of
22 students with disabilities and may also provide, or contract for the provision of,
23 educational services to any student suspended under this subsection in an alternative
24 school setting or in another setting that provides educational and other services. For
25 purposes of this subsection and ~~subsection (d1)~~ subsections (d1), (d4), and (d6) of this
26 section, the term "educational property" has the same definition as in G.S.
27 14-269.2(a)(1).
