## **SESSION LAW 2005-119 HOUSE BILL 1005**

## AN ACT TO ANNEX CERTAIN DESCRIBED TERRITORY TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF PINEVILLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** The corporate limits of the Town of Pineville are extended to include the entire territory located in the Town's Sphere of Influence on January 1, 2005, excepting and excluding that area bounded by the easterly margin of the right-ofway of Lancaster Highway on the east and McAlpine Creek on the north. As used in this act, "sphere of influence" means that area designated as such in annexation agreements between the Town of Pineville and other municipalities under Chapter 953 of the 1983 Session Laws, or under other general or local acts.

**SECTION 2.** The Town of Pineville shall record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Mecklenburg County a detailed map of the area annexed by this act. **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective June 30, 2005.
