1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE WRITTEN PARENTAL CONSENT PRIOR TO THE
3	ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN SURVEY INFORMATION FROM STUDENTS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 29 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended
6	by adding a new section to read:
7	"§ 115C-405. Written parental consent required prior to the acquisition of certain
8	survey information from students.
9	(a) Unless a local school administrative unit receives prior written informed
10	consent from a student's parent or legal guardian the local school administrative unit
11	shall not administer to a student any survey, assessment, analysis or evaluation that
12	reveals information concerning:
13	(1) <u>Political affiliations;</u>
14	(2) Mental and psychological problems potentially embarrassing to the
15	student or the student's family;
16	(3) <u>Sexual behavior or attitudes;</u>
17	(4) <u>Illegal, antisocial, self-incriminating or demeaning behavior;</u>
18	(5) Critical appraisals of relatives of the student;
19	(6) Income, other than that required by law, to determine eligibility for
20	participation in a program or for receiving financial assistance under a
21	program; or
22	(7) Social security number.
23	(b) <u>A local school administrative unit that violates the provisions of this section</u>
24	shall be subject to declaratory and injunctive relief but not to damages. A court may
25	award reasonable attorneys' fees as a part of the costs to a student or a parent who
26	prevails in an action brought pursuant to this section.
