The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 10A-10 reads as rewritten: "§ 10A-10. Fees of notaries. The maximum fees that may be charged by a notary for notarial acts are as follows: For acknowledgments, three dollars (\$3.00) six dollars (\$6.00) per signature. For oaths or affirmations without a verification or proof, three dollars (2) (\$3.00) six dollars (\\$6.00) per person. For verifications or proofs, three dollars (\$3.00) six dollars (\$6.00) per (3)
