1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND COUNTIES TO DONATE SURPLUS,
3 OBSOLETE, OR UNUSED PERSONAL PROPERTY TO OTHER
4 GOVERNMENTAL UNITS OF THE STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended
7 by adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 160A-280. Donations of personal property to other local governments.**

9 (a) A city or a county may donate to another governmental unit any personal
10 property, including supplies, materials, and equipment, that the governing board deems
11 to be surplus, obsolete, or unused. The governing board of the city or county shall post a
12 public notice at least five days prior to the adoption of a resolution approving the
13 donation. The resolution shall be adopted prior to making any donation of surplus,
14 obsolete, or unused personal property.

15 (b) For the purposes of this section, the term 'governmental unit' shall have the
16 same meaning as defined by G.S. 160A-274(a).

17 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
