1 The Governor shall designate these three local governmental officials seven 2 members on April 1 of years in which an election is held for the office of Governor, or 3 as soon thereafter as possible, and the three local governmental officials seven members 4 designated by the Governor shall serve on the Board in addition to the regular duties of 5 their city, town, or county office: Provided, that if for any reason any local 6 governmental official so designated member appointed pursuant to subdivisions (1) 7 through (6) of this subsection vacates the city, town, or county office or employment 8 which he the member held at the time of this designation, the Governor shall designate 9 some other local governmental official another member to serve until the next regular 10 date for the designation of local governmental officials members to serve on the Board."

11 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law, and the additional 12 members shall be designated by the Governor to serve until April 1, 2008, when their 13 successors shall be designated.
