SECTION 1. G.S. 14-415.15(b) reads as rewritten:	
"(b) Upon presentment to the sheriff of the items required ur	ıder
G.S. 14-415.13(a)(1), (2), and (3), the sheriff may issue a temporary permit for a per	riod
not to exceed 90 days to a person who the sheriff reasonably believes is in	an
emergency situation that may constitute a risk of safety to the person, the person	on's
family or property. The applicant may submit proof of a protective order issued ur	ıder
G.S. 50B-3 for the protection of the applicant as evidence of an emergency situat	ion.
The temporary permit may not be renewed and may be revoked by the sheriff witho	ut a
hearing."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2005, and applies	s to
orders issued on or after that date.
