SECTION 1. G.S. 163-278.7(f) reads as rewritten:

"(f) The State Board of Elections shall provide training for every Every treasurer of a political committee, prior to the election in which the political committee is involved, committee shall participate in training as to the duties of the office.office within three months of appointment, and at least once every four years thereafter. The State Board of Elections shall provide each treasurer with a CD ROM, DVD, videotape, or other electronic document containing the training as to the duties of the office,office in person, through and shall conduct regional seminars for in person training, seminars, and through interactive electronic means. The treasurer may choose to participate in training prior to each election in which the political committee is involved. All such training shall be free of charge to the treasurer."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
