6	SECTION	1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the	
7		al Resources the sum of two million eight hundred dollars	
8	(\$2,800,000) for the 2	006-2007 fiscal year for repairs and renovations of facilities	
9	located on the grounds of the Palmer Memorial Institute State Historic Site. These funds		
10	shall be allocated as follows:		
11	(1)	\$1,400,000 to renovate Kimball Hall for use as a multipurpose	
12		center and special exhibition facility.	
13	(2)	\$800,000 to upgrade the Charlotte Hawkins Brown Museum	
14		and the Carrie M. Stone Teachers' Cottage, which houses the	
15		site's visitors' center.	
16	(3)	\$600,000 to renovate the Massachusetts Congregational	
17		Women's House, which served as the Institute's economics	
18		practice house.
