The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Each county shall have the numbers of magistrates and additional seats of district court, as set forth in the following table:

14 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
15 Department the sum of forty-four thousand three hundred twenty-seven dollars
16 (\$44,327) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish an additional magistrate for
17 Alamance County.

18 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
19 Department the sum of forty-three thousand nine hundred eighty-five dollars (\$43,985)
20 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish an additional part-time Judicial Assistant I
21 position in District Court District 15A.

22 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
