A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN ADDITIONAL MAGISTRATE FOR  
ALAMANCE COUNTY AND AN ADDITIONAL JUDICIAL ASSISTANT  
POSITION IN DISTRICT 15A.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-133(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Each county shall have the numbers of magistrates and additional seats of district court, as set forth in the following table:

12           **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial  
 13 Department the sum of forty-four thousand three hundred twenty-seven dollars  
 14 (\$44,327) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish an additional magistrate for  
 15 Alamance County.

16           **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial  
 17 Department the sum of forty-three thousand nine hundred eighty-five dollars (\$43,985)  
 18 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish an additional part-time Judicial Assistant I  
 19 position in District Court District 15A.

20           **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
