A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR COMMUNITY-BASED CORRECTIONS
PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Criminal Justice Partnership Program.

**SECTION 2**. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of three hundred ninety-two thousand seven hundred sixty-two dollars (\$392,762) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Drug Treatment Court Program.

**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department, Office of Indigent Defense Services, the sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Sentencing Services Program. The funds shall be used to match offenders with appropriate community resources and provide information to the courts regarding community resources.

**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide expansion funding for the Women at Risk program for female offenders in Buncombe and surrounding counties.

**SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
