1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 2005 GENERAL ASSEMBLY,
2 REGULAR SESSION 2006, TO CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT
3 TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE COMMERCIAL LEAKING PETROLEUM
4 UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND TO EXPEDITE THE
5 ASSESSMENT AND CLEANUP OF DISCHARGES AND RELEASES FROM
6 PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS AND TO FACILITATE
7 THE TRANSITION TO RELIANCE ON PRIVATE INSURANCE, AND TO
8 APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND
9 NATURAL RESOURCES TO COVER INCREASED PROGRAM OPERATING
10 COSTS AND THE COSTS OF ANY LEGISLATIVE SALARY INCREASE FOR
11 PERSONNEL WHO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM, AS RECOMMENDED BY
12 THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.

13 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

14 **SECTION 1.** The 2005 General Assembly, Regular Session 2006, may
15 consider "A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE
16 COMMERCIAL LEAKING PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK
17 CLEANUP FUND TO EXPEDITE THE ASSESSMENT AND CLEANUP OF
18 DISCHARGES AND RELEASES FROM PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND
19 STORAGE TANKS AND TO FACILITATE THE TRANSITION TO RELIANCE ON
20 PRIVATE INSURANCE, AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE
21 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO COVER
22 INCREASED PROGRAM OPERATING COSTS AND THE COSTS OF ANY
23 LEGISLATIVE SALARY INCREASE FOR PERSONNEL WHO ADMINISTER THE
24 PROGRAM, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW
25 COMMISSION."

26 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
