A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH THREE ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITIONS, FIVE VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANTS POSITIONS, AND TWO INVESTIGATOR POSITIONS FOR PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 21.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

40 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
41 Department the sum of two hundred fifty-four thousand eighty-eight dollars (\$254,088)
42 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the three additional assistant district attorney
43 positions authorized by this act.

1 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
2 Department the sum of two hundred forty-one thousand seven hundred seventy dollars
3 (\$241,770) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish five victim witness assistant
4 positions for Prosecutorial District 21.

5 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
6 Department the sum of one hundred twenty-seven thousand one hundred ninety dollars
7 (\$127,190) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish two investigator positions for
8 Prosecutorial District 21.

9 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
