1                                   A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH THREE ADDITIONAL  
3 ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITIONS, FIVE VICTIM WITNESS  
4 ASSISTANTS POSITIONS, AND TWO INVESTIGATOR POSITIONS FOR  
5 PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 21.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7                   **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

8           "(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each  
9 district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth  
10 in the following table:

38           **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial  
39 Department the sum of two hundred fifty-four thousand eighty-eight dollars (\$254,088)  
40 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the three additional assistant district attorney  
41 positions authorized by this act.

42           **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial  
43 Department the sum of two hundred forty-one thousand seven hundred seventy dollars

1 (\$241,770) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish five victim witness assistant  
2 positions for Prosecutorial District 21.

3           **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial  
4 Department the sum of one hundred twenty-seven thousand one hundred ninety dollars  
5 (\$127,190) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish two investigator positions for  
6 Prosecutorial District 21.

7           **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
