A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF  
2 VETERANS NURSING HOMES IN ASHEVILLE AND KINSTON.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
6 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of eight million seven hundred  
7 seventy-three thousand three hundred dollars (\$8,773,300) for the 2006-2007 fiscal  
8 year. These funds shall be allocated to provide a State match for the construction of two  
9 100-bed nursing homes to provide skilled care for the State's veterans. The nursing  
10 homes will be constructed, one in Asheville and the other in Kinston. These funds will  
11 match federal funds, thirty-five percent (35%) State funds, sixty-five percent (65%)  
12 federal funds.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
