Short Title: Trenton Sewer Funds. (Public) **Sponsors:** Representatives Wainwright and Preston (Primary Sponsors). Referred to: Appropriations. May 25, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO JONES COUNTY TO EXTEND SEWER LINES TO SCHOOLS WITH SEPTIC SYSTEMS IN THE TOWN OF TRENTON. Whereas, the elementary and middle schools in the Town of Trenton continue to use septic tanks; and Whereas, storms have often led to sewage overflow, causing these schools to close and prompting health concerns for students and school personnel; and Whereas, the Jones County Commissioners and the School Board support the installation of sewer lines to these schools; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Jones County the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to extend sewer lines to the schools in the Town of Trenton that are currently using septic tanks.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
