11	" <u>Sec. 5.43.</u>	Public Transportation Payments.
12	The Town m	ay, by ordinance, establish a program for accepting payments in lieu of
13	transportation	infrastructure improvements from applicants for development in
14	accordance with	the following standards:
15	<u>(1)</u>	Where a proposed new development in the Town or the Town's
16		extraterritorial planning jurisdiction is determined, as a result of a
17		traffic impact study, to place an increased demand on the public
18		transportation infrastructure, the Town may, as a condition of approval
19		of the proposed development, accept from the developer a payment
20		offered in support of public transit service.
21	<u>(2)</u>	The payments provided by the developer shall be calculated to be
22		reasonably equivalent to the cost of the transit system improvements
23		required to address the impact of the new development. The ordinance
24		may allow for a combination of partial payment of funds and partial
25		construction of transportation infrastructure improvements if the
26		Council determines that a combination is in the best interest of the
27		citizens of the area to be served.
28	<u>(3)</u>	Any payments made by a developer shall be used by the Town to
29		provide public transit capital improvements, including buses and bus

1	shelters, that will improve public transit service to the new
2	development or to provide roads or other transportation infrastructure
3	improvements that will serve the area of the new development."
4	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
