12		Town may adopt an ordinance to allow an applicant for development to			
13	offer, at the applicant's discretion, payments in support of the public transit system in				
14	lieu of providing transportation infrastructure improvements in order to satisfy a				
15	condition of approval of the proposed development. The ordinance may allow for both				
16	the payment of funds and the construction of transportation infrastructure improvements				
17	if the Council determines that a combination of payments and construction is in the best

19		ordinance shall provide for the following standards:			
20	<u>(1)</u>	A traffic impact study demonstrates that the proposed new			
21		development in the Town or in the Town's extraterritorial planning
