Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF A MALT BEVERAGE UNDER THE 3 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL LAWS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 18B-101(9) reads as rewritten: 5 'Malt beverage' means beer, lager, malt liquor, ale, porter, and any 6 other brewed or fermented beverage containing at least one half of one 7 percent (0.5%), and not more than six percent (6%), one-half of one 8 percent (0.5%) alcohol by volume." 9

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
