SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Kings Mountain Historical Museum Foundation, a nonprofit organization, the sum of twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to assist the Museum in preserving the historic Barber log house and the George Washington Cornwell House.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
