A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR RESIDENTS OF FORSYTH COUNTY TO FISH IN
THE WATERS OF TRIAD PARK WITHOUT A FISHING LICENSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the licensing requirements of
G.S. 113-270.1B, a resident of Forsyth County fishing with hook and line using natural
bait is entitled to the same exemption provided to residents of Guilford County under
G.S. 113-276(e) when fishing on waters located in Guilford County but within Triad
Park, a park jointly owned by Guilford and Forsyth Counties and situated in both
counties.

SECTION 2. This act applies only to Forsyth County.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
