3	THE CITY TO SELL PERSONAL UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT TO PUBLIC
4	SAFETY EMPLOYEES UPON THE EMPLOYEES LEAVING THE CITY'S
5	EMPLOYMENT.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Subsection 33(c) of the Charter of the City of Raleigh, being
8	Chapter 1184 of the 1949 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 312 of the 1991
9	Session Laws, Chapter 649 of the 1993 Session Laws, and Chapter 323 of the 1995
10	Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
11	"(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, nothing
12	herein shall be construed as preventing any official or employee covered by this section
13	from purchasing a utility service offered to the general public at uniform rates, sludge
14	generated at a wastewater treatment plant, farm products grown on City-owned or
15	City-leased farms, and mulch produced at the City's yard waste processing center. In
16	addition to the transactions authorized in this section, the City may sell items of
17	personal uniforms and equipment, excluding weapons, to public safety employees upon
18	their separation from the City's employment. The items may be sold by private sale at
19	the prices and under the terms and conditions that the City Council may establish by
20	resolution."
21	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
