The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 20-175 is amended by adding a new subsection	on to read:
"(d) Local governments may enact ordinances restricting or prohibit	ting a person
from standing on any street, highway, or right-of-way excluding side	walks while
soliciting, or attempting to solicit, any employment, business, or contributi	ons from the
driver or occupants of any vehicle. This subsection does not perm	it additional
restrictions or prohibitions on the activities of licensees, employees, or c	ontractors of
the Department of Transportation or of any municipality engaged in co	nstruction or
maintenance or in making traffic or engineering surveys."	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
