1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT INCREASING THE FORCE ACCOUNT LIMIT OF DAVIE COUNTY AS
3	TO AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES STATION.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 143-135 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 143-135. Limitation of application of Article.
7	Except for the provisions of G.S. 143-129 requiring bids for the purchase of
8	apparatus, supplies, materials or equipment, this Article shall not apply to construction
9	or repair work undertaken by the State or by subdivisions of the State of North Carolina
10	(i) when the work is performed by duly elected officers or agents using force account
11	qualified labor on the permanent payroll of the agency concerned and (ii) when either
12	the total cost of the project, including without limitation all direct and indirect costs of
13	labor, services, materials, supplies and equipment, does not exceed one hundred
14	twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) or the total cost of labor on the project does not
15	exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000). This
16	force account work shall be subject to the approval of the Director of the Budget in the
17	case of State agencies, of the responsible commission, council, or board in the case of
18	subdivisions of the State. Complete and accurate records of the entire cost of such work,
19	including without limitation, all direct and indirect costs of labor, services, materials,
20	supplies and equipment performed and furnished in the prosecution and completion
21	thereof, shall be maintained by such agency, commission, council or board for the
22	inspection by the general public. Construction or repair work undertaken pursuant to
23	this section shall not be divided for the purposes of evading the provisions of this
24	Article."
25	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies only to the expansion and improvement of
26	Emergency Medical Services Station Number One.

- **SECTION 3.** This act applies to Davie County only. **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 27
