4	Whereas, the cougar is a member of the small cat family and is sometimes
5	referred to as the panther, puma, catamount, mountain lion, and painter; and
6	Whereas, an adult cougar can reach eight feet in length, including its tail, and
7	can weigh more than 150 pounds; and
8	Whereas, cougars are solitary nocturnal predators that feed primarily on deer
9	and other small mammals; and
10	Whereas, cougars were once prevalent in North Carolina, but in recent years
11	only a few sightings have been reported; and
12	Whereas, adopting the cougar as the official State cat of North Carolina
13	would help bring about awareness of this magnificent animal; Now, therefore,
14	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
15	SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
16	new section to read:
17	" <u>§ 145-22. State cat.</u>
18	The cougar is adopted as the official State cat of the State of North Carolina."
19	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
