2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE
3	TO ESTABLISH A TRADE OFFICE IN THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA.
4	Whereas, currently, North Carolina maintains foreign office operations that
5	serve the citizens of North Carolina by matching hundreds of North Carolina businesses
6	with partnering opportunities in these prosperous foreign nations; and
7	Whereas, North Carolina has an opportunity to establish a trade office in the
8	Taipei World Trade Center in the Republic of China; and
9	Whereas, the government of the Republic of China has graciously offered to
10	defray a considerable amount of the expenses in establishing the new trade office,
11	including offers from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to subsidize rental fees for four
12	years and from the Taipei World Trade Office to provide free office equipment; and
13	Whereas, a trade office in the Republic of China would serve as an ideal
14	location to market North Carolina's tobacco, soybean, and biotechnology products; and
15	Whereas, some Republic of China companies such as Delta Electronics,
16	Foxconne Electronics, Winstron, and Everlight Chemicals have operation centers in
17	North Carolina; Now, therefore,
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
19	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
20	Department of Commerce the sum of eighty-two thousand four hundred thirty-two
21	dollars (\$82,432) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to establish a trade office in the Taipei
22	World Trade Center in the Republic of China.
23	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
