Short Title: Perquimans Bear Hunting. (Local)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE PROHIBITION ON BEAR HUNTING IN
PERQUIMANS COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Chapter 582 of the 1979 Session Laws is repealed as it applies
to Perquimans County.

SECTION 2. G.S. 113-133.1(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Because of strong community interest expressed in their retention, the local
acts or portions of local acts listed in this section are not repealed. The following local
acts are retained to the extent they apply to the county for which listed:

...

Perquimans: Former G.S. 113-111; Session Laws 1973, Chapter 160; Session Laws
1973, Chapter 264; ~~Session Laws 1979, Chapter 582.~~ 264.

..."

SECTION 3. This act applies only to Perquimans County.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
