## **SENATE BILL 1288**

Short Title: Phase Out Medicaid County Share. (Public) Sponsors: Senators East; Allran, Apodaca, Blake, Brock, Goodall, Hunt, Smith, and Tillman. Referred to: Health Care. May 11, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PHASE OUT THE COUNTY SHARE OF THE NONFEDERAL SHARE 3 OF MEDICAID COSTS OVER A FOUR-YEAR PERIOD. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the 6 county share of the nonfederal share of Medicaid costs, excluding administrative costs, 7 shall be phased out over a four-year period, as follows: Effective July 1, 2006, the county share of the nonfederal share, 8 (1) 9 excluding administrative costs, shall be eleven and one-quarter percent 10 (11.1/4%).11 (2)Effective July 1, 2007, the county share of the nonfederal share, excluding administrative costs, shall be seven and one-half percent 12 13 (7.1/2%).14 (3) Effective July 1, 2008, the county share of the nonfederal share, 15 excluding administrative costs, shall be three and three-quarters 16 percent (3.3/4%). 17 (4) Effective July 1, 2009, the nonfederal share of Medicaid costs, excluding administrative costs, shall be borne by the State. 18 19 SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2009, G.S. 108A-54 reads as rewritten: "§ 108A-54. Authorization of Medical Assistance Program. 20 The Department is authorized and empowered to establish a Medical Assistance 21 22 Program from federal, State and county federal and State appropriations and to adopt rules and regulations under which payments are to be made in accordance with the 23 provisions of this Part. The nonfederal share may be divided between the State and the 24 25 counties, in a manner consistent with the provisions of the federal Social Security Act, except that the share required from the counties may not exceed the share required from 26 27 the state. If a portion of the nonfederal share is required from the counties, the boards of county commissioners of the several counties shall levy, impose and collect the taxes 28

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required for the special purpose of medical assistance as provided in this Part, in an 1 2 amount sufficient to cover each county's share of such assistance. Each county shall be 3 responsible for the full cost of administering the Medical Assistance Program for the 4 county." There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 5 SECTION 3. 6 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Medical Assistance, the sum of one hundred twenty-six million five hundred thirty-eight thousand seven hundred 7 8 eighty-one dollars (\$126,538,781) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be 9 used to cover the cost to the State of reducing the 2006-2007 county share of the nonfederal share, excluding administrative costs, of Medicaid costs. 10

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SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
