Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL 3 ON RIVERS IN POLK COUNTY. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to possess or consume any alcoholic beverage on the waters of any river in Polk County or within 50 feet of the banks of any river in Polk 6 7 County. 8 **SECTION 2.** This act does not apply to the actions of a landowner or the 9 landowner's guests on the landowner's property and does not apply to that portion of the Green River that has been impounded to form Lake Adger. 10 **SECTION 3.** Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor punishable by a 11 12 fine of not less fifty dollars (\$50.00). **SECTION 4.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the 13 14 Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers 15 with general subject matter jurisdiction. **SECTION 5.** This act applies only to Polk County. 16 **SECTION 6.** This act becomes effective August 1, 2006, and applies to 17

offenses committed on or after that date.
