Short Title: No Alcohol on Polk County Rivers. (Local) Sponsors: Senator Apodaca. Referred to: State and Local Government. May 11, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL ON RIVERS IN POLK COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to possess or consume any alcoholic beverage on the waters of any river in Polk County or within 50 feet of the banks of any river in Polk County. **SECTION 2.** This act does not apply to the actions of a landowner or the landowner's guests on the landowner's property and does not apply to that portion of the Green River that has been impounded to form Lake Adger. **SECTION 3.** Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less fifty dollars (\$50.00). **SECTION 4.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. **SECTION 5.** This act applies only to Polk County.

SECTION 6. This act becomes effective August 1, 2006, and applies to
