8	"(d) The provisions of this disclosure statement section shall not apply to the			
9	following transfers:			
10	(1) A vehicle having a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 16,000			
11	pounds;			
12	(2) A vehicle that is not self-propelled;			
13	(2a) A vehicle sold directly by the manufacturer to any agency of the			
14	United States in conformity with contractual specifications;			
15	(3) A vehicle that is 10 years old or older; <u>older</u>, provided that a vehicle			
16	that is 10 years old or older but less than 20 years old shall have an			
17	odometer disclosure statement provided by the transferor to the			
18	transferee if a transferee requests the disclosure statement; or			
19	(4) A new vehicle prior to its first transfer for purposes other than resale."			
20	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2006.
