12	(2) A vehicle that is not self-propelled;	
13	(2a) A vehicle sold directly by the manufacturer to any agency of the

15	(3) A vehicle that is 10 years old or older; <u>older</u>, provided that a vehicle	
16		that is 10 years old or older but less than 20 years old shall have an	
17		odometer disclosure statement provided by the transferor to the	
18		transferee if a transferee requests the disclosure statement; or	
19	•	4) A new vehicle prior to its first transfer for purposes other than resale."
