A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO CONTINUE FUNDING FOR THE 2005 SOLDIER, SAILOR, MARINE,
AIRMEN, AND GUARDSMEN SUPPORT ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 1A.1(a) of S.L. 2005-445 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 1A.1.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to a Reserve for the Military Morale, Recreation, and Welfare Fund in the Office of State Budget and Management for the 2006-2007 fiscal year the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000).(\$1,000,000) in recurring funds."

SECTION 2. Section 1A.2 of S.L. 2005-445 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 1A.2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Conservation Grant Fund established under G.S. 113A-232 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000).(\$1,000,000) in recurring funds. Funds distributed to the Conservation Grant Fund under this section must be used for compatible land use and conservation easement type acquisitions of land adjacent to military bases and flyways."

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
