AN ACT TO REPEAL THE LOCAL MODIFICATIONS OF G.S. 153A-335
PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF SUBDIVISIONS IN RUTHERFORD
COUNTY AND THEREBY SUBJECTING THE COUNTY TO FULI
APPLICATION OF THE GENERAL LAW, AND TO PROVIDE FOR A STUDY
ON THE USE OF CLEAR PROCEEDS IN A MANNER THAT WILL ALLOW
FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE USE OF TRAFFIC CONTROL
PHOTOGRAPHIC SYSTEMS BY LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 313 of the 1979 Session Laws are
repealed. This section applies to Rutherford County only.
<b>SECTION 2.</b> The Legislative Research Commission may study the impac
of the various decisions of the North Carolina courts on the definition of clear proceed
as it relates to the funding and operation of traffic control photographic systems by
cities and towns in the State. The Commission may recommend to the Genera
Assembly statutory changes that define clear proceeds in a manner that allows their use
for the continued operation of these traffic control systems.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
