AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH TWO ADDITIONAL

ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND TWO ADDITIONAL VICTIM

WITNESS ASSISTANTS FOR PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 24. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred sixty-nine thousand three hundred eighty dollars (\$169,380) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional assistant district attorneys authorized by this act.

**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of ninety-six thousand seven hundred eight dollars (\$96,708) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish two additional victim witness assistant positions for Prosecutorial District 24.
