<b>SECTION 1.</b> Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S.	S. 20-54,
a town may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of electric golf carts on an	y public
street or road within the town.	
By ordinance, a town may require the registration of golf carts, char	
for the registration, specify the persons authorized to operate golf carts, and sp	•
required equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of golf	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> Section 2 of Chapter 13 of the 1995 Session Laws, as a	amended
by Session Law 2002-82, reads as rewritten:	
"Sec. 2. This act is enforceable by any company policeman appointed under	
74E of the General Statutes, certified by the North Carolina Criminal Justice E	
and Training Standards Commission, and employed by the Seven Lakes Lan	
Association, Inc., or by any law enforcement officer acting within the	officer's
territorial jurisdiction."	
<b>SECTION 3.</b> Section 1 of this act applies only to the Towns of R	Rose Hill
and Bladenboro. Section 2 of this act applies only to Moore County.	

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
